

## MRA Uniform Expectations

MRA was founded on the core value and philosophy of being a community of learners who take care of each other, our environment and our materials. MRA families who choose to attend our school, take pride in belonging to our special and unique community and this is reflected partly through our uniform requirement.

MRA students have always had a uniform policy. Over time, concessions were made for Cedars students and during the pandemic, some of the expectations were further loosened. This has deteriorated to the point that it is often unclear what is an MRA uniform and what is not.

Returning to our philosophy and core values was central in the decision making process for returning to the standard MRA uniform. Uniform tops will be purchased through the school; it is not our intent to make money on the uniforms, therefore we will sell them at cost. ### Beginning in September, 2022

**Tops:** Red, Navy, or White polo, t-shirt, long-sleeve shirt/sweatshirt with MRA logo

- Bottoms may be purchased anywhere but must meet guidelines below

**Bottoms:** pant, shorts, or skirts

Leggings may only be worn under shorts/skirts and must be **solid black, navy or white.**

No athletic pants (yoga pants/sweat pants), jeans, or clothing with holes/rips

**Grades 1st-8th will have until January 2023 to follow new uniform guidelines, including purchasing tops with the MRA logo. If you are purchasing school clothes anyway, you may want to order the new shirts now.**

### September, 2022–December, 2022

**Until January, 2023 students in grades 1st-8th will have the following uniform guidelines:**

**Tops:** Red, Navy, or White polo shirts, t-shirts, long-sleeve shirt/sweatshirts w/ no logos OR the MRA logo

**Bottoms:** Khaki, Black or Navy pant, shorts, or skirts

Leggings may only be worn under shorts/skirts and must be solid black, navy or white.

No athletic pants (yoga pants/sweat pants), jeans, or clothing with holes/rips.

**Beginning in January, 2023 all tops must be purchased through MRA and have the MRA logo**

### For ALL students beginning September, 2022

- Free dress Friday; clothes must be free from rips/tears and may not contain any inappropriate language or pictures. Students may wear other MRA clothing on these days (i.e jog-a-thon shirts, Roots shirts, etc)
- No hats are allowed
- Athletic (tennis shoes) are recommended each day; a pair must be worn for PE class
- Rubber boots are required for outdoor learning

Financial assistance is available for families qualifying for Free/Reduced meals.
