September 27, 2023 Dear Families,

We are so excited to begin on our reading journey and battles. We had our Battle of the Books informational meeting. Ms. Daisy and I will be facilitating/coaching the 3rd-5th grade teams and Mrs. Hood and I will be doing the 6th-8th grade teams. If your student expressed interest in participating in the 2023-24 OBOB program this year they should have picked up a book list. If they do not have a book list, please let us know so we can get that sent to you and your student right away. What we did discuss were the following items:

1. Students will be deciding if they want to commit to participating in the Battle of the Books program. If a student commits to participating it is extremely important that they follow through on their commitment as it can impact their team if they decide to quit mid-season. Please talk with your student seriously about their commitment to read 4-8 of the 16 books and fully participate if they decide to move forward with joining OBOB. The season technically runs from Summer 2023 through April 2024, so we are picking this up part way through; however, we are confident that we have plenty of time to prepare ourselves to be serious contenders this season.

2. The teams will divide up who would be the primary and secondary reader on each of the titles. Please see the attached list. Copies of the books are available through Molalla Public Library both onsite and through their LINCC system. Audiobooks and ebooks are also allowed. If you are having a hard time locating a title, please let us know. Please encourage your child to be reading as many of these books as they can.

3. We are sending a survey for you to fill out to let us know what your student's availability is throughout the week. Ideally we would love to be able to accommodate everyone's schedules but with many students participating in a variety of extracurricular activities, it may not be possible for all OBOB participants to meet at the same time. If you could please let us know what days and times work best for you. Once that is figured out, we will be able to establish a regular meeting time and place. We will begin school battles in January. I will send out a schedule of these battles towards the end of December. We encourage families to attend if possible.
