Student Attendance

Students with regular, consistent attendance are shown to be more successful academically, socially and emotionally at every level; elementary, middle and high school. But more importantly for us, much of what we do at MRA is hands-on and project based and often cannot be duplicated outside of the classroom. So, when our students miss, they are not receiving the same educational experience as their peers.



Excused absences should not exceed 5 days within a 3 month period or 10 days within a six month period;

Excused Absences Include:

- Personal illness, medical/dental/mental health appt.
- Illness or death in the family
- Family emergencies
- Release time for religious purposes
- School sponsored events

If your student will be absent, please notify the main office. They will be provided with work when they return. Teachers are not expected to provide work in anticipation of a student absence.

Per Oregon state Students who miss 10 or more consecutive days will be withdrawn from school.





Important Uniform Update

Unfortunately there have been serious supply issues with our polo uniform shirts and those will not be available for months.

All short and long sleeve t-shirt orders made prior to August 3rd have been fulfilled and are available at the office for pick-up. Sweatshirt orders and orders made after August 3rd are being completed at this time.

If you ordered a free t-shirt in the Spring, that is also available in the office.

Due to the supply issues and not all orders being filled by the start of school and because we do not want parents to have any additional expenses, the following decision was made regrading uniforms. This is in effect until January, 2023.

MRA Bottoms (same requirements in place):

- Pants, shorts, or skirts in solid black, navy, or khaki
- Leggings may only be worn under shorts/skirts and must be solid black, navy or white.
- No athletic pants (yoga/sweat pants)
- No jeans or clothing with rips/tears

MRA Tops

- Encouraged to wear navy, red or white but will not require until Jan. 2023
- Tops must be free from rips/tears
- Not explicit language or inappropriate references
- All undergarments covered (no spaghetti straps/crop tops)

MRA K-5 and Middle School Models

Students in grades 6-8 will transition into a true middle school model this year. They will change classes every period and will have the opportunity to take 4 different electives over the course of the year.

Students in K-5 will see the addition of an integrated arts class each week. Integrated art will combine art instruction with music/movement and literacy.
